MEMBER PARTICIPATION INITIATIVE

WHAT IS IT?

This is a point system that provides annual recognition to all actively involved members of the Chapter. Points will be earned for attending events, participating on committees, and enrolling in courses at chapter or national level. Points will be earned and counted individually and by firm from September 1 through August 31 each year. Recognition will be announced at the Annual Fall Conference for the year ending August 31.

WHAT IS THE PURPOSE?

The Initiative will provide recognition of members that take time out of their busy schedules and member firms that support member participation in chapter activities, programming and committee work.

QUALIFYING ACTIVITIES:

The following is the schedule of qualifying events and points earned by each individual participating.

Regional Membership Meeting.....	1 point
Emerging Construction Professional Forum.....	1 point
Chapter Sponsored Seminars- Half-day in length.....	2 points
Chapter Sponsored Seminars- Full-day in length.....	4 points
Chapter Annual Fall Conference	4 points
AGCA Annual Convention	4 points
AGCA National Level Education Seminars.....	4 points
Chapter STP OnLine Courses.....	5 points
Other training programs.....	depending on length, 1-4 points
Points earned annually, per member involved - Serving on Chapter Committees.....	5 points

PROGRAM REWARDS:

Individual recognition will be inclusion in the Premier Member Circle for the year. The annual Premier Member Circle will include individuals that reached a maximum level of participation points between September 1 and August 31. Recognition will include a polo shirt and print recognition statewide and in your local area.

Company recognition will be in the form of a plaque. The plaque will be awarded to the member firm that has the highest cumulative points from all individual employee points for the award year. The AGC Nebraska Building Chapter Premier Member Firm will be recognized at the Fall Conference for the points earned by employees from September 1 to August 31 of that year. The annual recipient will be recognized in print media statewide and in their local areas.
