With the passage of LB 889 in 2008 political subdivisions along with school districts will likely increase the design-build and CM@Risk building projects in our market area. LB889 specifies a step-by-step selection and execution procedure to carry out the project.

MARK MITTS, P.E. and Education Chairperson for the Mid-America Chapter of DBIA will address the roles and responsibilities of the Performance Criteria Developer and how RFP criteria documents are developed per the process outlined in the Act. Additionally, he will talk about the qualification based selection process as it applies to CM@R.
