**5:00-5:30pm - The 10 Rules of Networking and Building Professional Relationships** - Don Wrieth, Kiewit Building Group and AGC Board President, along with Jean Petsch, Building Chapter, will share insights from their many years of professional work. Networking and making connections are fundamental skills you need to possess to secure a job and move up the career ladder.

**5:30-6:30pm** - Each officer team will be assigned a time to meet with the Education Committee. See the RFP for more details. Each interview should not exceed 10 minutes. While the interviewing is going on the rest of the group will be engaged in socializing/networking activities and liquid refreshments.

**6:30pm - Dinner will be served.** The Education Committee and the AGC Board of Directors have been invited to join us for dinner.
