Conceptual Planning and Scheduling and Risk Mitigation

- This course is **NOT** teaching how to create a detailed schedule in any software application.
- This course **WILL** provide tools to strategically plan the project with input from all team members.
- These tools include how to consistently communication schedule progress, delays, contingencies, and recovery plans. The course includes basic understanding of key definitions and concepts so that non-scheduling experts can work confidently during the schedule management process throughout the life span of the job.
- Material will be presented from the perspective of risk identification from beginning to end of schedule management. This will include identification of key questions to address during planning phases. Hands-on group exercises will enhance learning about how to plan with a productive group sessions and identify common mistakes in a project schedule.
